Pages 7-8	<p>Due to changes in Oklahoma's accountability system and the timeline for data release, Oklahoma City Public Schools on behalf of Oklahoma Centennial High School is requesting to revise the 2014-2015 SMART goal based on the percent proficient/school report card grade on the Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test (OCCT) instead of the performance index.</p> <p>Reading SMART goal Based on the preliminary release of Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test (OCCT) data, Oklahoma Centennial High School (OCHS) will increase the percent proficient for all students in reading (English II and English III) from a D in the 2013-2014 school year to a C or better in the 2014-2015 school year.</p> <p>Math SMART goal Based on the preliminary release of Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test (OCCT) data, Oklahoma Centennial High School (OCHS) will increase the percent proficient for all students in mathematics (Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II) from an F in the 2013-2014 school year to a D or better in the 2014-2015 school year.</p> <p>Performance Pay Policy If OCHS raises the overall school report card grade from an F (2013-2014) to a D or better (2014-15), all high school certified staff/teachers will receive a one-time stipend of \$4000.00. The stipend will be pro-rated based on the length of service during the 2014-2015 school year and will be based on the teacher's class assignment at the time of testing as determined by the site principal. Split level teachers, who teach both middle and high school students, will receive \$2000.00 for the high school portion of their teaching assignment. Building principal and Assistant Principals will receive a one-time stipend of \$5000.00.</p> <p>Per our conversation with Mr. Richard Caram in the Fall of 2014, we submit this application amendment form for OSDE approval.</p>
