

Title III, Part A, Year Two and Year Four Improvement Plan Timeline

August

- Final ACCESS for ELLs Test data is shipped to Oklahoma.

September

- Data Services calculates AMAO 1 and 2. Office of Accountability and Assessment calculates AMAO 3 no later than mid-September.
- New AMAO Notifications are sent to all Title III districts and individual consortia members at the end of September.
- Districts that have not met Title III AMAOs for two consecutive and four consecutive years are notified that a Year Two or Year Four Improvement Plan is required at the end of September.

October

- Year Two and Year Four Improvement Plans are due from districts and consortia members no later than the last day of October.
- Districts and individual consortia members in Year Two and Year Four of Title III Improvement invited to attend one of four ELL Data Digging Workshops to be held October through December.

November

- The Director of English Language Learner (Title III-A) and Migrant Education (Title I-C) Programs and the Program Specialists for Instruction of English Language Learners will review all Improvement Plans no later than mid-November. Feedback will be provided via phone call, email, and technical assistance visits.
- If any changes are required to Title III Improvement Plans, districts and individual consortia members must provide final copies by the end of November.

December
- July

- The director of English Language Learner (Title III-A) and Migrant Education (Title I-C) Programs and the Program Specialists for Instruction of English Language Learners will monitor the fidelity of the implementation of Title III Year Two and Year Four Improvement Plans through participating in the Federal Programs Consolidated Monitoring Process, performing on-site technical assistance visits, and providing point-to-point videoconferences.
